13. Daytime running lights	When activated, all of the vehicle's lights will be on whenever the key is turned on (low-beam headlights). Note: The high-beam function will work only if the light switch is turned to the "on" or #3 position.	Inactive	See special features for Canadian lights

16. Radio pre-sets linked to key	Radio will remember pre-set stations for key that is currently in the ignition.	Disabled	Disabled	Not currently available on North American models
17. Park Distance Control - audible warning	Audible warning indicating that the PDC system is activated will operate when dash button is pressed.	Active	Active	
18. Park Distance Control - rear volume level	Controls the volume of the PDC "beeps" from the rear sensors. Select range of 1 through 6 for the amount of increase desired.	Option 3	Option 3	

NOTE: Navigation system voice commands for the USA use the accent and language terminology of a UK male or a Spanish female. (These can be selected from the Audio/Nav system menu.) Canadian vehicles use a UK male or a French female. Your Land Rover Technician can configure your vehicle with the following additional language options: UK female, American male, American female, French male, Spanish male, and "JAMES." Terminology used will vary, such as "motorway" versus "highway." The "JAMES" setting uses the accent of a UK male, but with American terminology.
